



A top American professor gave lecture to ISSBS students

On 19 May 2008 the International School for Social and Business Studies (ISSBS) hosted dr. Jay Liebowitz, a world's leading expert in knowledge management. Dr. Liebowitz is a professor at the John Hopkins University in the USA which ranks 19th among world's best universities.

Despite its short existence ISSBS had the honour to host a leading American expert who during his 3-day visit gave a lecture to students of the programme Knowledge Management. He talked about knowledge management as a competitive tool for strengthening innovations, new knowledge and new products. He stressed that the future of knowledge management lies in intergenerational knowledge transfers.

During his visit he also met with the mayor of the Municipality of Celje, Mr. Bojan Šrot, accompanied by ISSBS's dean, doc. dr. Srečko Natek.

In addition to dr. Liebowitz, this year the faculty has hosted two other foreign lecturers and two ISSBS lecturers have visited Portugal in the frames of the Erasmus programme.

ISSBS also actively cooperates with the local community, as demonstrated in guest lectures of numerous field experts and in organisation of workshops, such as the first meeting of human resources professionals of Celje region entitled "The Bologna Reform of Higher Education and Employment", which will take place on 3 June 2008.
