



## Acknowledged Polish lecturer's visit at the ISSBS

**On 23-24 April 2009, International School for Social and Business Studies (ISSBS) hosted dr. Zbigniew Pastuszak, an acknowledged lecturer of the Polish Maria Sklodowska-Curie University. During his visit, organised in the framework of the Erasmus programme, he gave lectures to students of the optional course Supply Chain Management.**



Dr. Zbigniew Pastuszak is the head of two departments of the Maria Sklodowska-Curie University, namely the department of Management of Information Systems and the department of Supply Chain Management. He is a vice-chancellor of the private College of Enterprise and Administration (WSPA) where he also lectures in the frameworks of the courses Supply Chain Management and e-Business.

During his visit he gave lectures to third-year students of the programme Economy in Modern Society. He introduced them to foundations of Supply Chain Management (SCM), new economy and its influence on solutions of SCM, new methods of added value creation in the framework of SCM, strategies of e-SCM and case studies.

Third-year students of the programme Economy in Modern Society showed a lot of interest in dr. Pastuszak's lectures and they thought him a great expert in the field.
