



Meeting of human resources professionals of Celje region at the ISSBS

On 3 June 2008 the International School for Social and Business Studies (ISSBS) organised the first expert meeting of human resources professionals of Celje region entitled “The Bologna Reform of Higher Education and Employment”.

ISSBS is aware of the fact that employers have insufficient information on the Bologna reform of higher education and its implications for employment of Bologna study programmes graduates. Therefore, ISSBS’s associate deans for education, mag. Valerij Dermol and Suzana Košir, informed them on the characteristics of the Bologna reform, such as 3-level studies and the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) used to evaluate students’ work. They emphasised the tendency to shorter studies and employment opportunities of Bologna study programmes graduates.



During the discussion human resources professionals from various companies (Gorenje, Pivovarna Laško, Etol, Pošta Slovenije, etc.) highlighted the current situation of employment in their organisations and recognition of new Bologna degrees. They expressed their interest in participating in preparation of the faculty’s study programmes and willingness to share information on what knowledge and skills young job seekers lack.
