Summer School 2011 will encourage and develop participants' creativity and innovation in order to identify, design and develop international business opportunities. Business ideas based on innovative approaches to existing solutions are the basis for a successful start and sustainable growth of new companies and are also an excellent starting point for international business opportunities. Summer school's main focus will therefore be on the practical development of participants' creative thinking and entrepreneurial innovation by means of so called **Teamwork and creativity workshop** and **Simulation of Market Developments Workshop**.

Courses will demonstrate various aspects of entrepreneurship, research and development, product improvements, new marketing approaches and other skills that are needed for successful implementation of a new business idea. The key academic fields Summer School 2011 focuses on are entrepreneurship, innovation processes, intercultural experiences in context of international management and European integration processes. Participants will be faced with real business challenges provided by participating companies, which stem from their activity on domestic and foreign markets. Solutions will then be presented to the representatives of these organizations.

We anticipate participation of students from different European and non-European countries. After successful completion of summer school's study obligations each participant will receive 9 ECTS credits for the study course Entrepreneurship.

Expected results of Summer School 2011 are motivated participants with a developed skill for a different approach to business ideas and a gained knowledge of implementation of their ideas in an international environment.

- an individual paper (approx. 8 pages) after the completion of the Summer School on the topic **“Encouraging Entrepreneurship in my Home Country”**. Deadline for submission of the paper via e-mail is 30 August 2011.

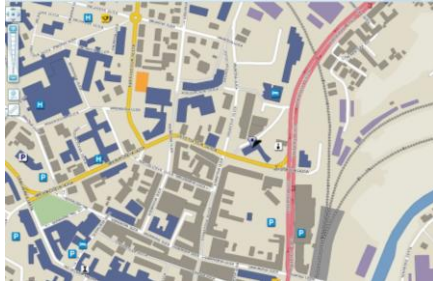

Please note that all Summer School participants will be accommodated in a hostel. This means that you will occupy rooms with more than one bed and share them with your fellow students.

Students from Slovenia do not have accommodation arranged and paid for by the Summer School programme. ## 8. Expenses and financing

Summer School 2011 has **no Tuition Fee and accommodation costs for students enrolled at partner higher education institutions** (HEIs) in the project (partner HEIs are: International School for Social and Business Studies, Universidade Portucalense Infante D. Henrique, Business Academy SouthWest, Uniwersytet Marii Curie-Skłodowskiej, Fachhochschule Kiel, Politechnika Lubelska).

Students should bring forward their proofs of travel (eg. flight/train ticket, boarding passes, taxi/toll receipts etc.). Without these documents (if you lose them or refuse to bring them forward) we will not be able to refund you for your travel costs.



**Students from other HEIs** have to pay **Tuition Fee (360 €)**, **accommodation costs (240 €)** and **cover their travel costs** unless it has been agreed otherwise.

**All participants have to pay Registration Fee (100 €)** that covers study materials, excursion and social programme **until 15 June 2011**. ISSBS students and Erasmus students at ISSBS have a discount.

Celje is the third largest town of Slovenia and one of Slovenia's most dynamic and quickly developing cities. With its central position and historical heritage it is the centre of Savinja region in terms of business, trade, culture, education and tourism. The city of Celje was the seat of the famous Counts of Celje in 14th century. It is also well positioned in the wider European region and is thus a perfect starting point to several major European cities such as Trieste, Venice, Budapest, Graz and Vienna. ## 11. How to get to Celje?

### By plane

You can easily reach Celje through the main Slovenian airport, called Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport (104 km from Celje, airport is 26 km from the centre of Ljubljana), which has daily connections with most European capitals (for instance London, Brussels, Copenhagen, Warsaw, Madrid). One way transport from Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport to Celje costs app. 15 eur by bus/per person or app. 100 eur by taxi/3 to 4 persons.

Celje can also be reached through other near airports such as Airport Graz (119 km from Celje) or Ronchi dei Legionari Airport Trieste (197 km from Celje). One way train ticket from Graz to Celje costs app. 30 €, however there is no direct railway connection between Trieste and Celje. To come from Trieste to Celje you can take the bus to Ljubljana, and then from Ljubljana to Celje, which all together costs app. 20 €.

### By train

Celje can be easily reached from Ljubljana with frequent daily connections (app. 6 eur/per person/one way). Ljubljana has regular railway connections with all neighbour countries and Central Europe.

### **By car**

Slovenia has a very good highway network, which also connects the country with Italy, Austria, Hungary and Croatia. It is necessary to buy a vignette before driving on Slovenian highways. Celje lies next to highway A1 (Šentilj-Srmin) between Ljubljana (79 km from Celje) and Maribor (51 km from Celje).

## **12. Daily life**

### **Currency**

Slovenia's currency is euro. In Slovenia you can use most debit and credit cards including Maestro, Visa, MasterCard and American Express. Most banks are open from Monday to Friday, 9 am.-12 am. and 2 pm.-5 pm. Some have different working hours. Nearest banks to ISSBS and MCC Hostel:

### **Traffic restrictions**

Fines for over speeding are very high in Slovenia. The speed limit in settlements is 50 km/h, outside of settlements 90 km/h, on roads reserved for motor vehicles 100 km/h and on highways 130 km/h. The lights of your vehicle have to be turned on 24 hours a day. You have to use winter equipment on your vehicle between 15 November and 15 March. You have to use seat belts at all times. The use of mobile phones is prohibited while driving.

### **Voltage**

Voltage in Slovenia is 220 V.

### **Water**

In Slovenia tap water is drinkable.

### **Phoning**

You can make phone calls at post offices which are usually open on weekdays between 8 am. and 7 pm. and on Saturdays until 1 pm. When making an international phone call you have to dial 00, a foreign country's international code and a phone number. To call Slovenia you have to dial 00, the national code 386 and a town code (Celje - 3, Maribor - 2, Ljubljana - 1). You can call national telephone information service at 1188 or international telephone information service at 1180. Most of the people in Slovenia use mobile phones. You can borrow a SIM card from one of our mobile operators (Mobitel, Simobil, Tušmobil etc.) for the duration of your stay in Slovenia.

### **Media**

Slovenian cable television carries Slovenian commercial (POP TV, Kanal A, ...) and public televisions (SLO 1, SLO 2) as well as English, Austrian, German, Italian, Croatian and Serbian channels. In Celje you can also watch the local television programme TV Celje, which mostly reports on local news and events.

Some international newspapers and magazines can be bought at tobacconists in the centre of Celje or in shopping malls, and also in some supermarkets.
